# Installation Instructions

**Bracket Options**The appropriate number and type of brackets will be included based on rod length and design choice.

Fasteners are not included. Proper fasteners, screws and mounting hardware must be determined by the installer based on mounting surface material.










#### Round Decorative Traverse Bracket (130-2064) - 4" Return Round Decorative Extended Traverse Bracket (130-2066) - 51/2" Return






# Square Decorative Traverse Bracket (130-2164) - 4" Return Square Decorative Extended Traverse Bracket (130-2166) - 51/2" Return




# Square Double Decorative Traverse Bracket (130-2167) - 7" Return

#### Ceiling Mount Bracket (ZBK-1000Z)




# **Metal Premium Traverse Rod Installation Instructions**

#### 1. Install Brackets


- Determine placement of end brackets based upon rod length.
- Determine height (distance from floor) of brackets based on length of draperies, floor clearance required and bracket design.

#### **Attach Wall End Brackets**

- Fasten brackets securely to mounting surface. Installer must furnish the proper fasteners based on type/material of mounting surface.
- If included, evenly space additional brackets between end brackets. All brackets must be level for rod installation.



Standard Heavy Duty Wall Brackets attach directly to wall.




# 2. Attach Rod to Brackets

Inserting mounting clip into front lip of Track at "A".

Pivot the back of track up to allow cam lock "B" to rotate and tightened to catch the back lip of track.

Ceiling mount, double mount and decorative bracket installations use the same mounting clip (93630) and rods attach the same way.




Track Splice Clip

#### **Splicing Traverse Rods**

- If 2 Traverse Rods are to be spliced, use Half Round Internal Splice (130-4099) or Flat Fascia Internal Splice (135-4088) to join 2 traverse rods.
- Use Track Splice Clip with bracket supplied to mount spliced rods to wall.
- screws to secure.





# 3. Remove Any Extra **Unneeded Carriers**

Before hanging drapery count the number of wheeled carriers your drapery will require. If there are more carriers than needed they should be removed.


Looking at the bottom of the drapery rod, loosen End Stop screw so that End Stop swings to release wheeled carriers.


Remove any extra carriers and capture end most carrier with End Stop to lock remaining carriers within track.

Tighten End Stop Screw to lock carriers in track.


# 4. Install Cord Safety Device and Tension Pulley

- For child and pet safety, install safety devices provided.
- If cord safety devices are not installed traverse rod will not function properly.






# 5. Add Finials, End Caps, or Returns to Rod
